Alora Vordana

Praxis' wife, Alora, born in 920 RSY on Coruscant, served in the Republic Intelligence Agency after graduating from the Coruscant Military College, where she met Praxis. The two married after graduation and built both a family and military careers, with Alora earning strong respect within intelligence for her skill and dedication. She was described as having long black hair, bright blue eyes, and faint freckles. She gave birth to six children, showing particular closeness with the twins in their early years. Alora tragically died at 41 from complications during the birth of her youngest, Elara, leaving behind six children, including a newborn daughter and a grieving family.



Early History & Education

Born into the heart of the Republic on Coruscant in 908 RSY, Vordana's early childhood is a matter of speculation, with few official records existing prior to his enrollment in the Coruscant Military College. It was here that he first distinguished himself, not through physical prowess alone, but through aptitude for strategy. Praxis graduated with top honors in Advanced Military Education Theory and Strategy.
