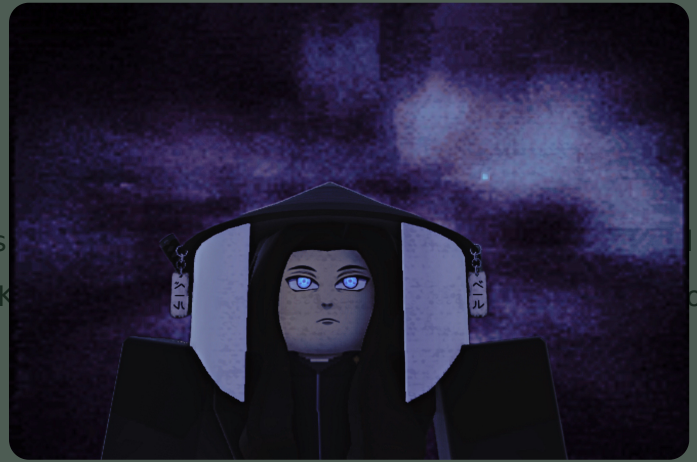
Creation of The Fragments
