

Fifth Hokage - Y'mir Yuki

Origin

Kato Yuki was born in 9 BVE, a refugee cut off from his home. Despite this, he quickly proved to be a skilled shinobi during the reign of Carter Uchiha. Kato had two brothers, Asda and Raiden, with whom he maintained a close bond. However, he was a troubled child, often discouraging and neglecting those around him.
