# A World Without War

Judar began making extremely risky but significant moves the moment he set foot on the Mainland. He immediately sought to build relationships with every village leader and leading figure within the Mainland, soon gaining rapport with every village leader at that time, including the Land of Mountains, where he developed a student-teacher relationship with [Ikari Uchiha](#).

This was all for his dream of a world without war. Judar had a single goal with the "special talent" bestowed upon him, and he intended to achieve it by any means necessary. Judar revisited [Avalon](#) several times, specifically for a certain person after discovering their cousin Park Namikaze within the Mainland. ### **"A Land of Harmony."**

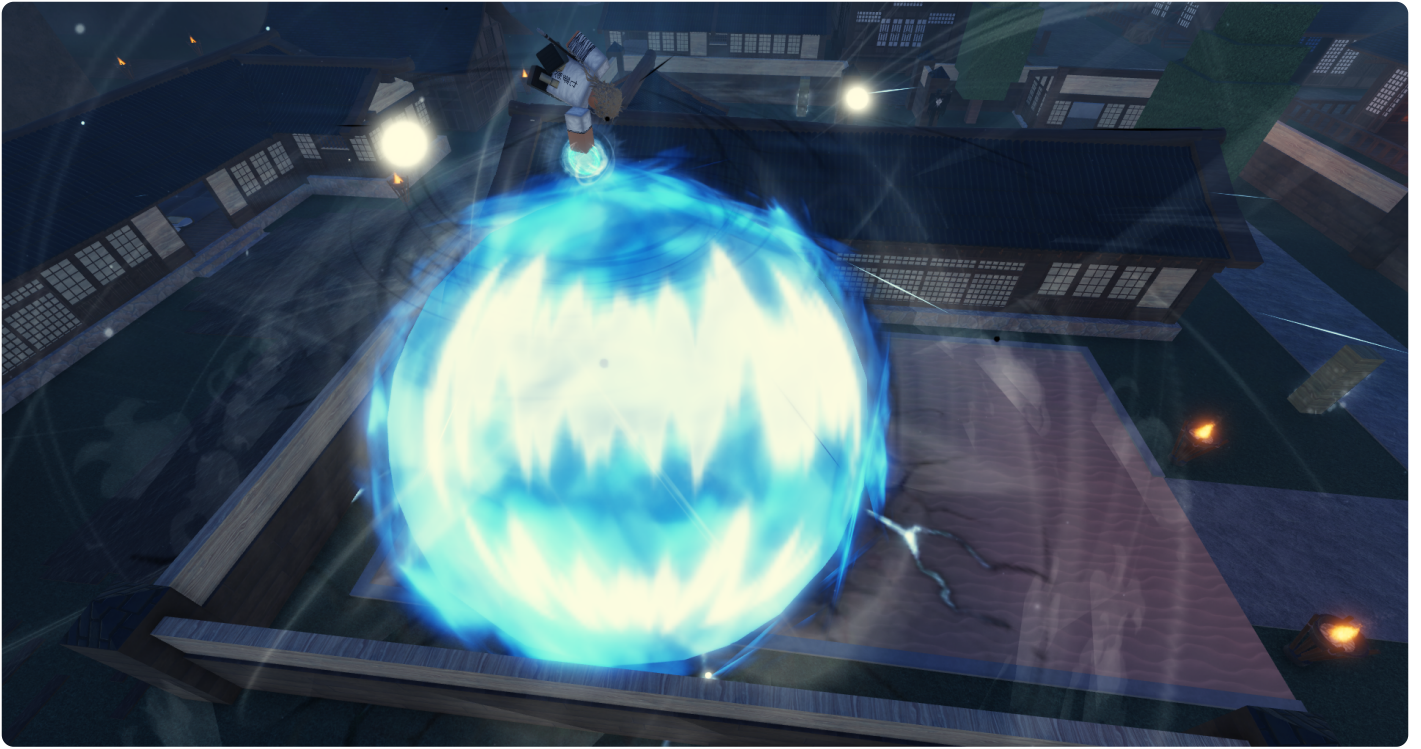
