

Second Hokage - Carter Uchiha

Early Years and Leadership

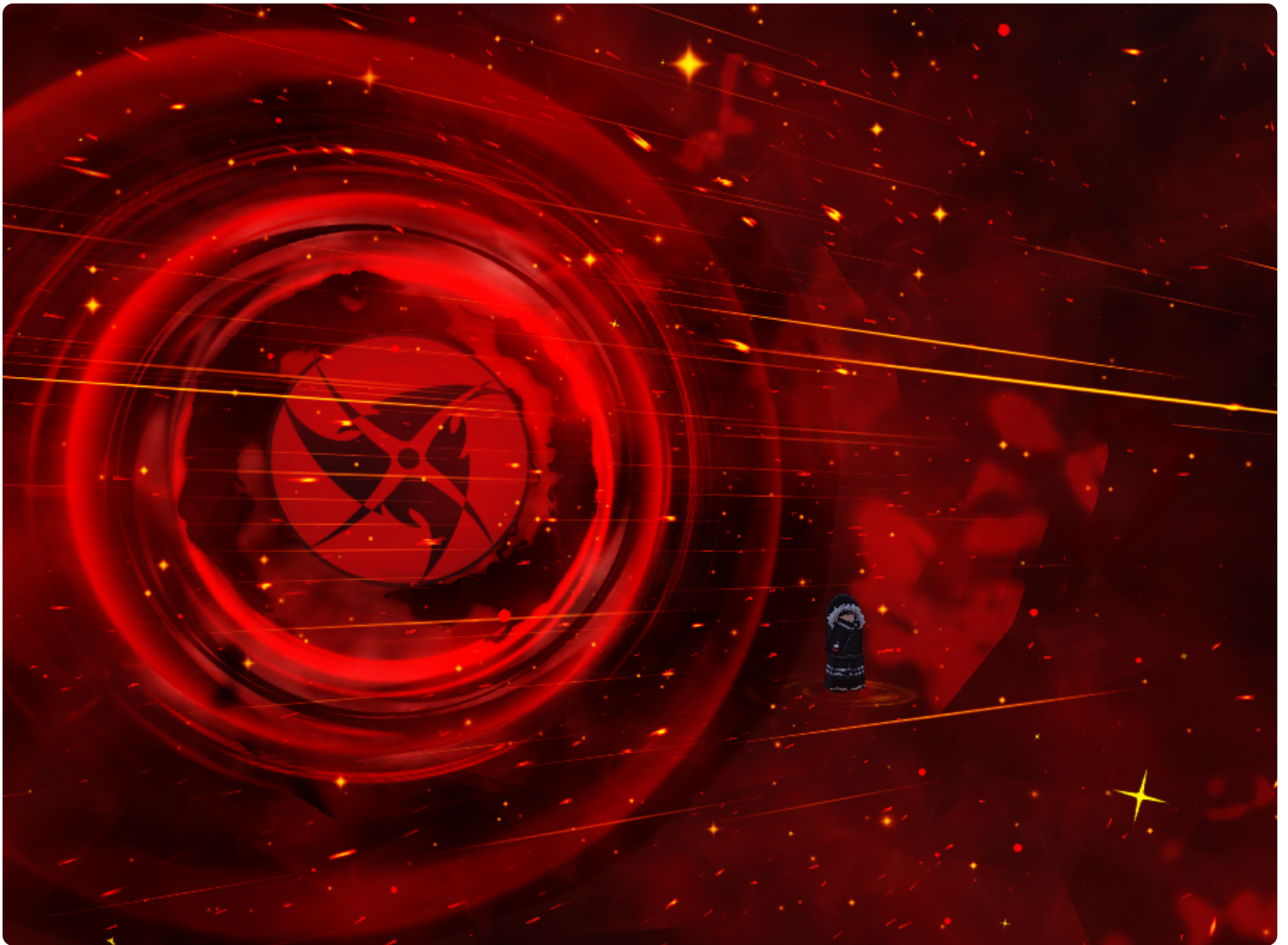

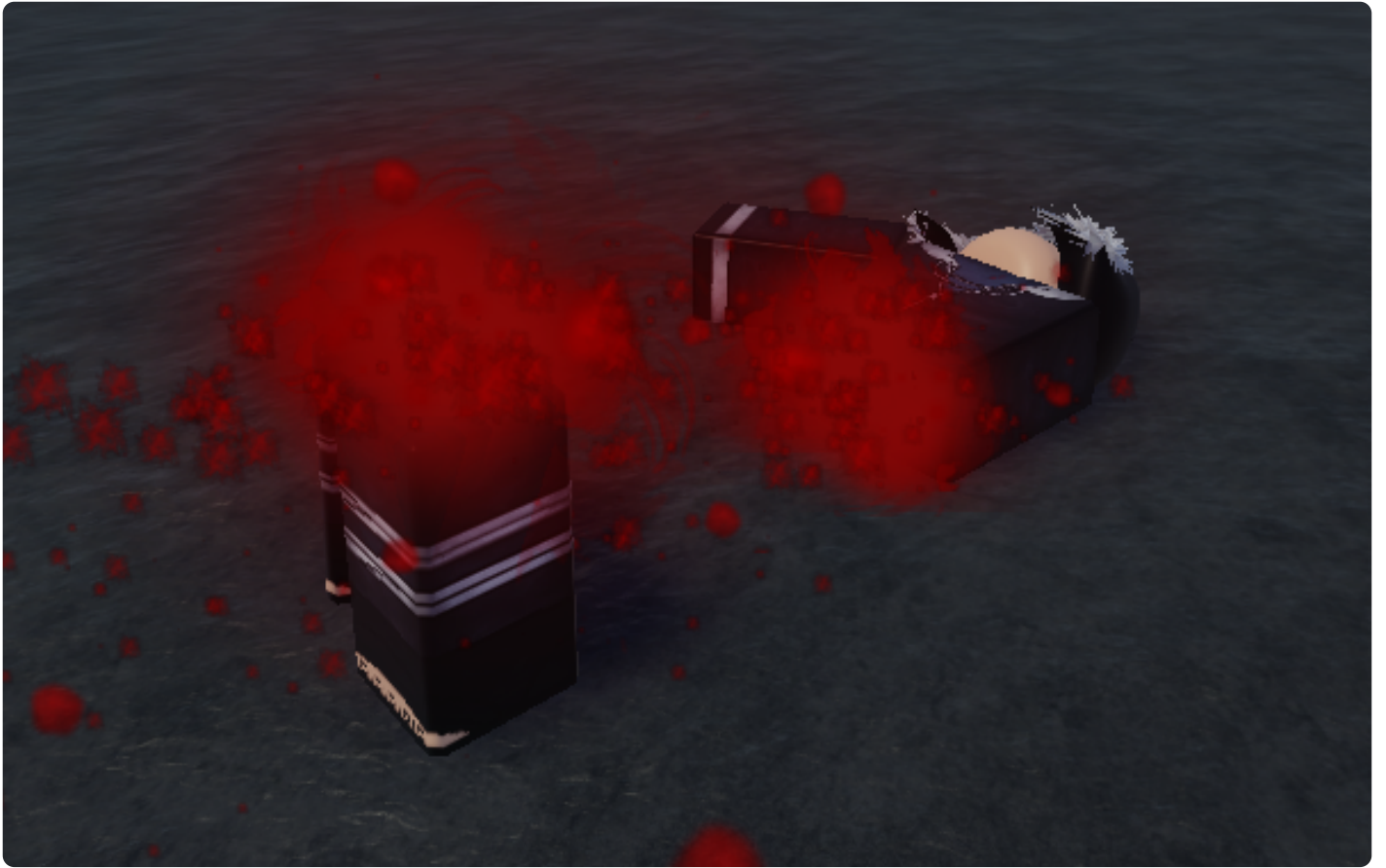
Carter Uchiha's "Tears of Eternity"
