## Origins

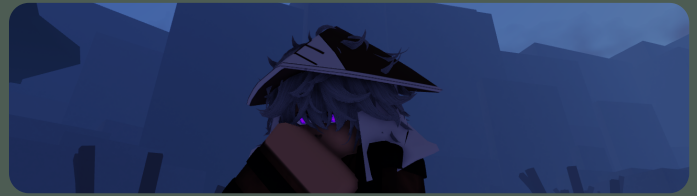

# The Sixth Tsuchikage

After returning from his journey, Midas was appointed the assistant of Iwagakure as Ni Miyajima's right-hand man, standing by him through thick and thin.
