History

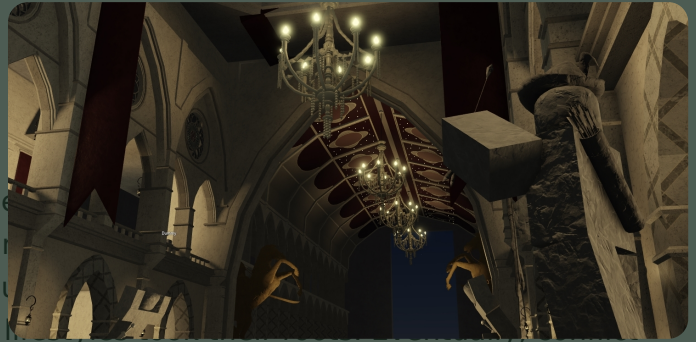
