## Society and Culture

Korasa's society is practical, resilient, and shaped by frontier conditions. The population is composed of settlers, transport crews, and Republic-aligned personnel, all contributing to the planet's role as a support world.

Daily life is defined by labor and adaptation. Unlike more developed planets, Korasa lacks large urban centers or cultural institutions, instead relying on small communities and cooperative systems to maintain stability.

There is a strong sense of self-reliance among its settlers, balanced by dependence on external systems for protection and broader coordination. Identity on Korasa is tied less to tradition and more to survival, contribution, and continuity.

## Government

Korasa operates under a Kaminoan Colonial Administration aligned with the Galactic Republic. Governance is decentralized, with local authorities managing settlements, resource distribution, and day-to-day operations.
