

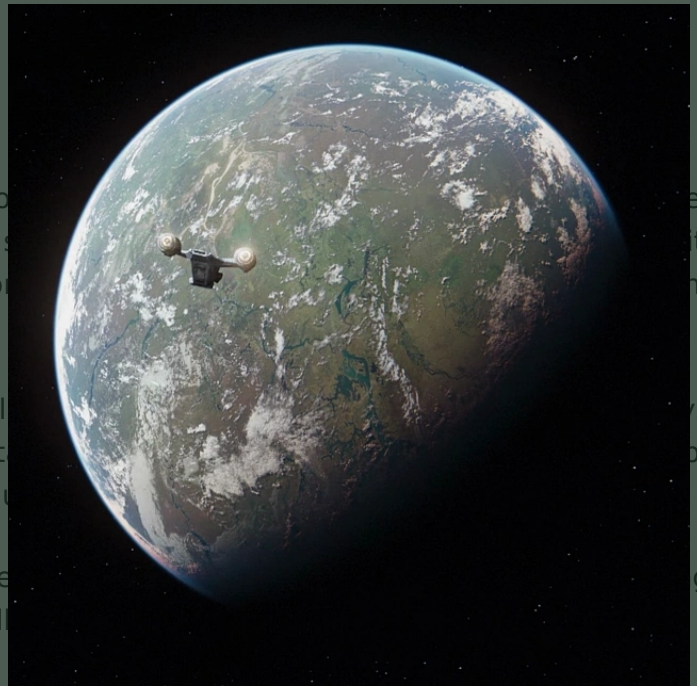
Tython

Overview

Tython is a remote and historically significant world, known as one of the earliest known centers of Force sensitivity. It has a strong and often volatile connection to the Force, often associated with imbalance.

From orbit, Tython appears varied and natural, with diverse oceans, and dense wilderness. Unlike more structured planets, it exhibits unusual environmental behavior, influenced by fluctuating atmospheric conditions.

Tython's importance is not strategic in the conventional sense, but is tied to the earliest traditions that would eventually shape the Jedi Order.



Society and Culture

Tython does not maintain a conventional society. There are no major cities, civilian populations, or structured economies. Instead, the planet is visited primarily by members of the Jedi Order and those seeking knowledge of the Force.

Historically, Tython was home to early Force practitioners who sought balance between opposing aspects of the Force. This legacy remains embedded in the planet's identity, where exploration is as much internal as it is physical.

Those who travel to Tython often do so for reflection, training, or study. The environment itself encourages isolation and introspection, with its unpredictable nature reinforcing the need for discipline and awareness.

Government

Tython exists under informal Jedi custodianship. There are no centralized government and no permanent administrative authority.

Access to the planet is limited and largely controlled through the Jedi Order, ensuring that its historical sites and Force-sensitive regions remain undisturbed. Oversight is minimal but
